Mail for MAC



Go to your Settings



- In MAC OS X click the **Mail** icon
- Under the **Mail** tab select **Preferences**
- Click **Accounts** and select your Northwestel Webmail account

Change your Mail Servers

- Change your **Incoming Server Host Name** to pop3.northwestel.net if you are currently using **POP3** settings or imap.northwestel.net for **IMAP** settings
- Click on the scroll down menu beside **Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP)** and select **Edit SMTP Server list...** or **Server Settings**
- Under **Account Information** tab, change the **Server name (outgoing)** to smtp-auth.northwestel.net
- Select the **Advanced** tab and select **Use Default Ports** or change **Server Port** to 587
- Make sure the **Use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)** is checked
- Click **OK** and select the **Advanced** tab
- Change the **Server Port** to 995 for **POP3** or 993 for **IMAP** and make sure the **Use SSL** box is checked
- Click the red close button
