Go to your Settings



- From the home screen, touch **Email**
- Press the **Menu** key and then touch **Settings**
- Touch your Northwestel Webmail account

Change your Mail Servers

- Touch **Incoming Settings**
- Change your **Incoming Server Host Name** to pop3.northwestel.net if you are currently using **POP3** settings or imap.northwestel.net for **IMAP** settings
- Select SSL as a **Security Type**
- Change the **Server Port** to 995 for **POP3** or 993 for **IMAP**
- Touch **Done**
- Touch **Outgoing Settings**
- Change your **SMTP Server** to smtp-auth-northwestel.net
- Choose STARTTLS as a **Security Type** (some devices may call this SSL/TLS)
- Change your **Port** to 587
- Touch **Done**
