Go to your Settings



- Touch **Apps**
- Touch **Email** then **Menu**
- Touch **Settings** then **Account Settings** (if applicable)
- Select your Northwestel Webmail account
- Select **More Settings**

Change your Mail Servers

- Touch **Incoming Settings**
- Change your **Incoming Server Host Name** to pop3.northwestel.net if you are currently using **POP3** settings or imap.northwestel.net for **IMAP** settings
- Choose SSL as a **Security Type**
- Change the **Server Port** to 995 for **POP3** or 993 for **IMAP** then touch **Done**
- Touch **Outgoing Settings**
- Change your **SMTP Server** to smtp-auth.northwestel.net
- Choose STARTTLS as a **Security Type** (some devices may call this SSL/TLS)
- Change your **Port** to 587
- Check **Require Sign-In** and enter your username and password
- Touch **Done**
